

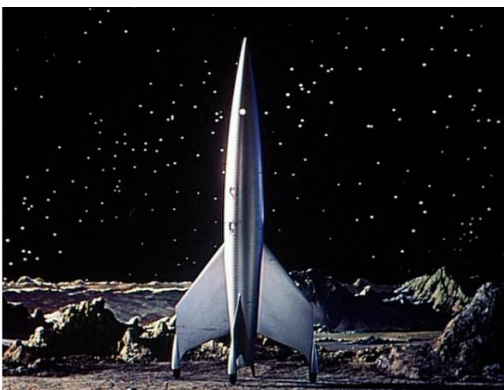
## Neil Armstrong

On July 20, 1969 American astronaut named Neil Armstrong was the first man to step foot on the moon.

### Child hood
