Childhood

Neil Alden Armstrong was born on the 5 of August, 1930 (Near Wapakoneta Ohio he was the eldest of three children (a boy and a girl) of Viola and Stephen Engel Armstrong. He flew seventy eight combat missions (during Korean War) when he was six he took his first airplane ride. When he was 16 he earned his flying licence,

was called to fight, in Korean War. After seventy
eight combat studies (1952) he then joined the
national advisory committee for aeronautics and
space Naca (this was later known as Nasa)

“perform a manned lunar landing and return” the
samples were basics, dark -coloured igneous rock
and (they were about 3.7 billion years old) Apollo
11 was the first spaceflight that landed on the
moon.
