

What's happening this term?

Year Group: 4

Science



In our Science sessions, we will be focusing on states of matter. The children will compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gasses; observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C)

Maths



In Maths this term, we are continuing with our MEP maths programme, where we will continue to reinforce number facts, solving problems, shape and measure.

English



In English this term, we will be learning about Greek mythology. The children will be learning about Theseus and the Minotaur then creating their own Greek myth. The children will also be learning lots of Greek myths to re-tell at the end share.
