Year Group: 6

Science



This term in science we will be focusing on Living things and their Habitats. (including the classification of living things) and Light.

We will also be practising our scientific enquiry skills, by planning and evaluating practical experiments.

Maths



In Maths this term, we will be focusing on properties of shape and measure (finding area, perimeter, volume, missing angles, etc). We will also be covering ratio, algebra and data handling. As always, arithmetic skills will be applied throughout each topic.

How can you help?

English



In English this term, we will be basing our writing around our project; writing letters and explaining how natural events such as volcanoes occur. Our fiction text will be based a suspense narrative.

How can you help?

Listening to your child read; asking them key questions and finding evidence from the text to support their answers.


PE/Games

R.E.




In R.E. this term, we will be focusing on the Journey of Life and Death which introduces children to the ways in which different religions observe significant milestones in life.

ART/DT

In French, we will be learning how to partake in basic conversation. This will involve and enhance the children's Speaking and Listening skills; developing through a combination of song and fun activities.
