

What's happening this term?

Year Group: 6

Science



This term in science we will be focusing on Evolution and Inheritance. The children will find out about palaeontology and the formation of fossils. They will also be looking at the work of Charles Darwin and his contribution to our understanding of how species have adapted over time.

Maths



In Maths we will be continuing to focus on; Place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and ensuring that these can be confidently applied throughout the term.

English



In English this term, we will be basing our writing around our project; creating our own versions of a traditional tale, as well as researching and writing a balanced argument.

In Computing this term, we will be preparing and presenting a presentation using a programme such as PowerPoint. We will be incorporating our project learning by trying to answer our project question.

R.E.




In R.E. this term, we will be focusing on Beliefs in Action in the World. Children will explore how the beliefs of different people influence their behaviour. We will have a particular focus on Christianity and Judaism.

ART



In Art this term, we will be carrying out collaborative art with an aim to create a piece of Art for display. We will be using a range of techniques and media to produce a final piece as well as researching a famous artist.

French



In French, we will be learning how to count in French as well as telling the time.

We will use our existing knowledge to continue having conversations in French.

Project



Our project this term is focusing on whether inspirational leadership requires team work. We will be looking at the British Monarchy and Leadership styles across the globe as well as considering what an inspirational leader is.

Music
