One day Ross spend £17.95. The next day, he spent £8.96. How much did he spend across the two days?

Calculate  $7354 + (643 + 73) =$

Over the weekend, Sarah saw 2,654 ants crossing the path. 3,284 more ants crossed the path on Monday. How many ants crossed the path altogether?
