This term one of our driver subjects for the school is History. In the Early Years Foundation Stage this links brilliantly with our curriculum areas of Understanding the World, Communication and Language, and Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

We will be immersing children in language related to past and present, linking this to their personal family, to them starting school, and to key events occurring this term.

Young children find concepts of time a bit tricky. Even questions which seem relevant - like "remember when you were a baby?" - can be really complicated to understand.

That's why we will be keeping our project in line with all of our EYFS teaching - fun, practical, and full of experiences.

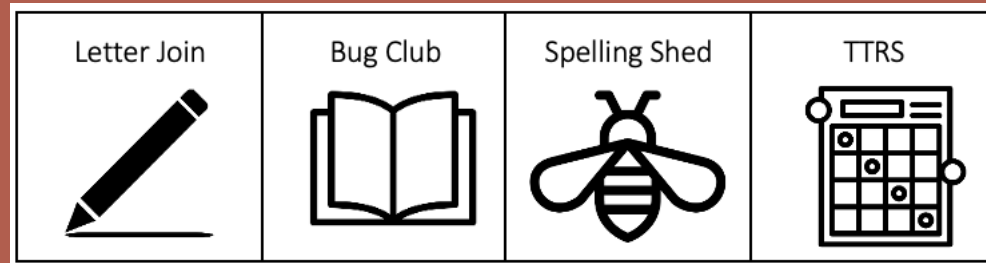
# Home Learning

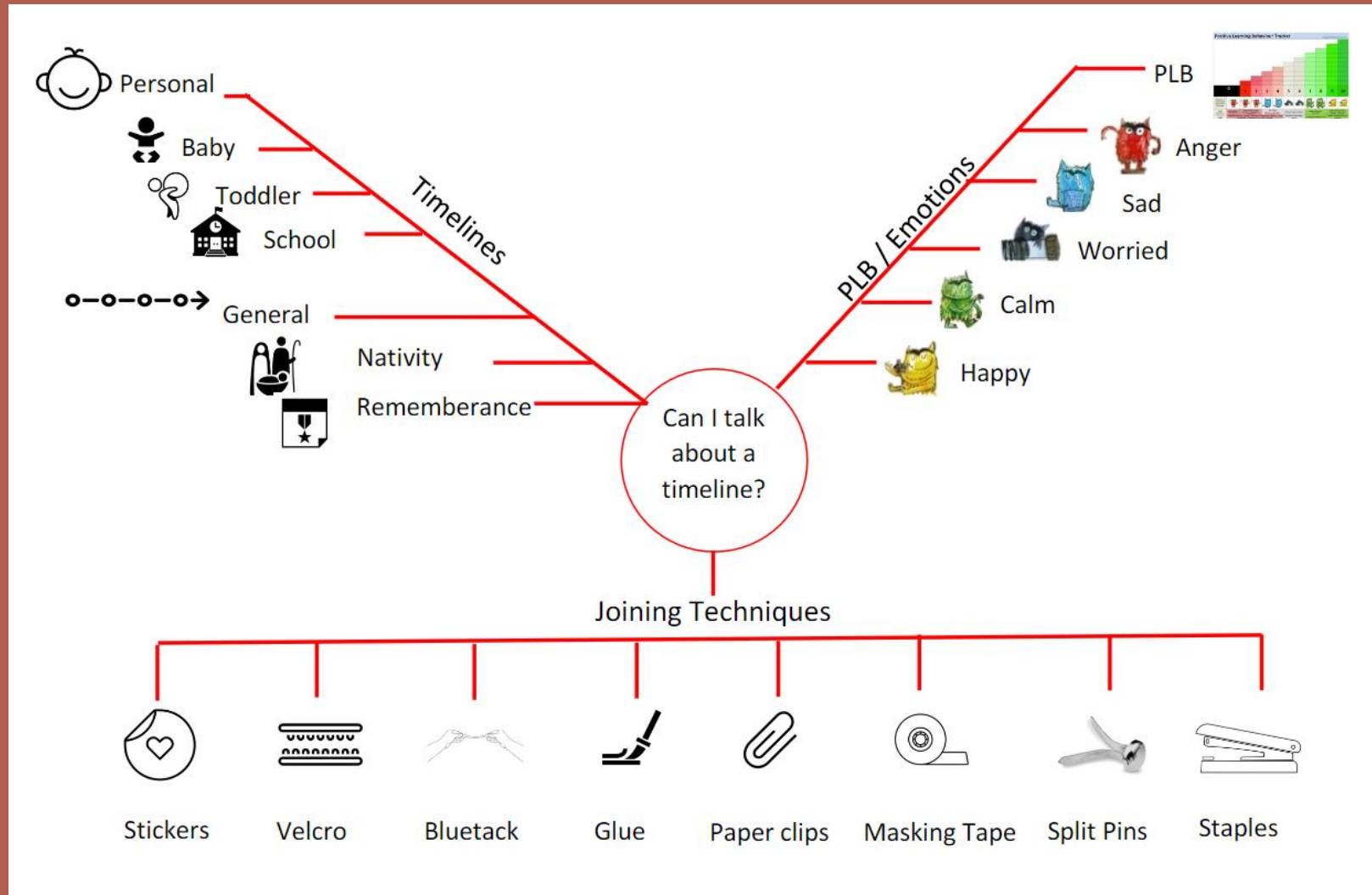
## Termly

<b>Tier 3</b>	<u>Subject specific words-</u> Attach, materials, construct, design, technology, media, technique
<b>Tier 2</b>	<u>Focus words:</u> glue stick, masking tape, sellotape, paper clip, scissors, treasury tag, staple, stapler, hole punch, join, construction, fix, create, explore, select, experiment, metal, plastic, wood, material
<b>Tier 1</b>	<u>Everyday words:</u> Stick, tape, glue, build, cut, make, use, choose, blocks, shape, paper
